① It was felt that proper service has been made.

Respondent's counsel was served - and advised he was not opposing Dr. Goldfinger's acknowledgement receipt.

CTC does not appear, but requested a change to para 9 of the order which was reasonable.

② A receiver should be appointed. At this point the Property has the characteristics of a wasting asset. Attempts by Goldfinger to sell under his security have been unsuccessful. There are several claimants against the Property, and a decision has to be made about what, if any, pre-sale improvements should be made. Considering the Froure Village criteria, it is just and reasonable to appoint a receiver and I do order Counsel to make the amendment sought by CTC to para 9 and file a clear order.
