- 2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the fees and disbursements of the Receiver as set out in the Second Report and the Rutman Affidavit are hereby approved.
- 3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that Zeifman Partners Inc. is hereby discharged as Receiver of the Property provided, however, that notwithstanding its discharge herein the Receiver shall continue to have the benefit of the provisions of all orders made in this proceeding, including all approvals, protections and stays of proceedings in favour of Zeifman Partners Inc. in its capacity as Receiver.

THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that Zeifman Partners Inc. is hereby 4. released and discharged from any and all liability that Zeifman Partners Inc. now has or may hereafter have by reason of, or in any way arising out of, the acts or omissions of Zeifman Partners Inc., save for wilful misconduct or gross negligence, while acting in its capacity as Receiver herein. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Zeifman Partners Inc. is hereby forever released and discharged from any and all liability relating to matters that were raised, or which could have been raised, in the within proceedings.
