- 3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that any interested party may apply to this Court to vary or amend paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order on not less than seven (7) days' notice

to the Receiver and to any other party likely to be affected by the order sought or upon such other notice, if any, as this Court may order.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the balance of this motion be adjourned to a date established by the Commercial List office in consultation with counsel for the Receiver and counsel for the Respondents.
