## **ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:**

- [1] The Receiver brings this motion for an Approval and Vesting Order (AVO) and an Ancillary Order. The motion is unopposed.
- [2] With respect to the AVO, I am satisfied that the Transaction should be approved. The Receiver conducted the Sale Process over a two-month period. The process was appropriate and targeted specific investors and stakeholders within the feminine hygiene product industry. The Transaction was the only one that arose from that process. The *Soundair* factors have been met. The Receiver recommends the Transaction. The only real alternative is a liquidation, which would be inferior. I am approving the Transaction and signing the AVO.
- [3] The Ancillary Order is also satisfactory. Specifically, the First Report is approved, as are the fees and disbursements, the proposed distribution and the discharge of the Receiver. The order contains a sealing order for the Confidential Appendices to the First Report pending the closing of the Transaction. I am satisfied that the requested sealing order for the Confidential Appendices meets the test in *Sierra Club/Sherman Estates* and that disclosure of this information would pose a risk to the public interest in enabling stakeholders of a company in receivership to maximize the realization of assets. I direct counsel for the Receiver to file a hard copy of the Confidential Appendices with the Commercial List office in a sealed envelope with a copy of the Ancillary Order and this Endorsement.
